This year, students ages 6 to 12 have a variety of choices in their summer program at Keystone. Students will choose the classes that best fit their interests, making a summer program that is custom designed for them.

Classes will be held in three sessions. The first two sessions will include a variety of class choices as well as a field trip option. Please see the enrollment form on reverse side for class offerings per session. The third session is dedicated strictly to field trips (field trips offered are the same in each session).

All classes are taught by Keystone's excellent elementary teachers and assistants and are appropriate for all students entering first through sixth grade.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Field Trip Program

This course is a great opportunity to discover everything Phoenix has to offer. Children will be traveling to great educational destinations such as the Mesa Southwest Museum, Cerreta's Candy Factory, and the Desert Botanical Garden. In addition, children will be visiting many "just for the fun of it" places such as Polar Ice and the movie theatre. A different adventure is planned for each day. There is an additional \$50 fee for this program.

Art and Artists from Around the World – NEW This Summer!

In this course, children will learn about artists from all over the world. Hands-on projects such as drawing, painting, and sculpting will be used to enhance the learning of other countries, cultures, and artists.

Book Writing

This year's writing course will have the end result of a beautifully bound book written by your aspiring young author. Students will each write an original story, illustrate it, and bind it into a book that will last forever.

Computers

This is an introductory course in computers. Children will be learning the basics of word processing, searching the internet, PowerPoint, and computer terminology. Students will use their skills to showcase various projects.

Cooking

In this course, children will be creating culinary masterpieces each day. They will be working with different kitchen tools to create dishes they can make themselves at home as well as those that may need adult supervision. At the end of the course, students will bring home their own collection of recipes. ****Please be aware that due to the large number of students usually enrolled in this course, we will be unable to accommodate any allergies.**

Discover Space – NEW This Summer!

In this course, students will explore the exciting frontier of outer space. Learn about stars, planets, comets, and meteors. Students will explore space through hands-on activities and investigations.

Dinosaurs

What dinosaur name means "fast thief"? How long were the arms of the average T-Rex? In this course, students will become knowledgeable about all kinds of prehistoric facts. Students will play games, create crafts, and even design their own dinosaur.

Drama

This year's drama class will include lessons and games used to improve presentation skills, imagination and cooperation. Students will work together to write and produce a play that they will have the opportunity to showcase to the other summer school students.

Math Lab
