FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ's):

How will the proceeds from the raffle be used? Playground improvements and the general fund (which includes items such as teacher salaries and benefits).

How much are tickets? \$100 each or three for \$250. Sell four tickets and you receive one free. Purchase four tickets and receive one free (that's four tickets for \$350!).

What is the procedure for selling tickets?

1. Completely fill out both the ticket and the order form. Please make sure it is clearly legible.
2. Fill in the number of tickets sold and the payment method on the order form. Cash, checks (made out to Keystone Montessori), and credit cards are accepted.
3. Tear the ticket into two parts. Give the large portion of the ticket stub to the buyer.
4. Turn in the small portion of the ticket stub (with the buyer information legibly filled out), the order form, and the cash, check, or credit card information to the Keystone office. For credit card purchases, Keystone will mail a receipt to the buyer.

Where can I get a complete list of raffle rules? The web site is www.KashandKeysforKids.org.

How do I obtain my "bonus" free tickets? For every four tickets you sell or purchase, the fifth ticket will be your "bonus" free ticket. It will be recorded and awarded when you turn in your tickets to the Keystone office.

My family lives out of state and they want to purchase tickets via the web site. Will this count toward my "bonus" free tickets? Yes! However, you must send an email to Michelle Block (michelleb@keystonemontessori.com) with the name(s) of the people you have solicited. When they purchase through the web site, this will be credited toward your "bonus" free ticket. Note: this is a change from our earlier communication that web site sales do not qualify as sales toward free tickets.

What happens when the tickets are sold out? The maximum number of total tickets in the raffle is 2100. Keystone cannot accept more than 2100 entries so you are encouraged to bring sold tickets promptly to the office!

Is the winner of the Early Bird drawing eligible for the main drawing? Yes, the early bird winner is eligible for the subsequent drawing and all prizes.

Is there an incentive for me to sell a lot of tickets? In addition to "bonus" free tickets, the family that sells/purchases the most tickets receives a dedicated parking space in a prime location at Keystone for 30 days.

Is my raffle ticket purchase tax deductible? The IRS has taken the position that raffle purchases are not tax deductible.

If I do not sell all the tickets sent to me, what do I do with them? Turn all unused tickets into the office.

When are the drawings? The early bird drawing is March 11th 2005. The final drawing is May 14th 2005.
