

# Diamondbacks December Update

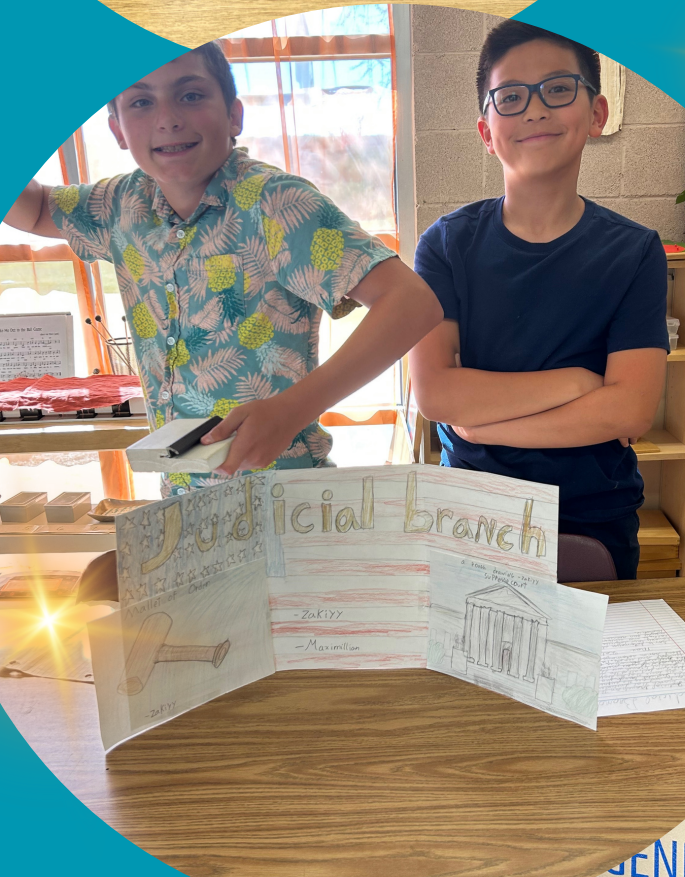
**Dear Parents,**
